WHAT IS A MEMORIAL SOCIETY?

The Calgary Co-operative Memorial Society was organized in 1966 under the Alberta Co-operative Associations Act. It is a non-profit, non-sectarian society administered by a board of volunteer directors.

Our members joined together to obtain dignity, simplicity and economy in their funeral arrangements. They come from all walks of life and from every age group, but all support the principle of simple, preplanned funerals.

Member's, on joining the Society, are charged a one-time only fee. This lifetime membership fee is \$40 per adult. Following the members' funeral, a Memorial Society Records Fee of \$35 is collected by the service provider and remitted to the Memorial Society. Membership is transferrable to other memorial societies in Canada, where they exist.

People who join the Society receive with their membership detailed information on services available in Southern Alberta and have reference to an understanding Funeral Home which has agreed to provide special benefits to Society members.

Plan A1

\$2,640, PLUS cemetery and/or cremation costs, and GST.

1. Transfer of deceased from place of death within Lethbridge city limits, Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
2. Preparation of documentation to obtain permits for burial or cremation
3. Imperial #2 grey cloth-covered casket (flat top) with white satin interior
4. Plywood cremation tray when cremation is selected
5. Use of chapel and staff for service, or equipment and staff required for service at church
6. Equipment to play recorded music provided by the family

7. Funeral Coach to Lethbridge cemetery
8. Two (2) copies of Funeral Director's Statement of Death

Plan A2

1. \$2,985, PLUS cemetery and/or cremation costs, and GST for Imperial #3 grey cloth-covered casket option
2. \$3,495, PLUS Cemetery and/or Costs, and GST for Imperial Diamond Wood Bar casket option

Included in cost:

3. Same as Plan A1, but substituting choice of casket described above.

Plan B1

\$1,395, PLUS cemetery and/or cremation costs, and GST

1. Transfer of deceased from place of death within Lethbridge city limits, Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
2. Preparation of documentation to obtain permits for burial or cremation
3. Cremation Container (Imperial plywood tray)

4. Preparation and delivery of obituary
5. Transportation of remains to Lethbridge cemeteries or crematorium
6. Two (2) copies of Funeral Director's Statement of Death

Plan B2

\$2,185, PLUS cemetery and/or cremation costs, and GST

1. Same as Plan B1, plus
2. Use of chapel and staff for service, or equipment and staff required for service at church
3. Equipment to play recorded music provided by the family

Plan B3

\$4,175, PLUS cemetery and/or cremation costs, and GST. Included in cost:

1. Transfer of deceased from place of death within Lethbridge city limits, Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
2. Preparation of documentation to obtain permits for burial or cremation
3. Embalming, dressing, cosmetology, casketing, hairdressing and use of visitation room for up to two hours, Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
4. Use funeral home's ceremonial (rental) casket, which includes the cremation container, for viewing for up to two hours, Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
5. Cremation container
6. Use of chapel and staff for service or equipment and staff required for service at church
7. Ushers for funeral service
8. Equipment to play recorded music provided by the family at a funeral service
9. Preparation and delivery of obituary
10. Transportation of remains to Lethbridge cemeteries or crematorium
11. Two (2) copies of Funeral Director's Statement of Death

Plan C

Any deviation from Plans A1, A2, B1, B2 or B3 (other than the listed additional costs) will void these plans. Members are entitled to a 10% discount on professional services, facilities, motor equipment, casket, urn and vault.
