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WHAT IS A MEMORIAL SOCIETY?

A Memorial Society is a group of people who have joined together to obtain dignity, simplicity and economy in funeral arrangements through advance planning. Members come from all walks of life and from every age group, but all support the principle of simple, preplanned funerals. The Calgary Co-operative Memorial Society (CCMS) was organized in 1966 under the Alberta Co-operative Associations Act. It is a non-profit, non-sectarian society administered by a board of volunteer directors.

Members, on joining the Society, are charged a one-time only fee. This lifetime membership fee is currently \$40 per adult. Following the members' funeral, a Memorial Society Record Fee (\$35) is collected by the service provider and remitted to the Memorial Society. Membership is usually transferrable to other memorial societies in Canada, where they exist, for a nominal fee.

People who join the Society receive with their membership detailed information on services available in Southern Alberta and have reference to an understanding Funeral Home which has agreed to provide special benefits to Society members.

Plans do not have to be selected or purchased at time of application. Plans may be paid at time of need.

PLAN A1

PLAN C
